## Tuscarawas Shelter at Firestone Metro Park

**Address:** 2620 Harrington Rd, Akron, OH 44319 (Tuscarawas Meadows)

Capacity is 92. There are 12 picnic tables (2 are universally accessible), 3 standard charcoal only grills (charcoal not provided), 2 electrical outlets, drinking water, fireplace (firewood available upon request) and a large open field. Hiking trails and fishing are nearby. The shelter is close to the parking lot and is universally accessible. The restrooms are approximately 100 feet from the shelter and are universally accessible. There are no lights inside or around the shelter or in the parking lot. Parking may be limited. *See the Permit Information and Guidelines sheet for details.* Pets are **not** permitted in the buildings, or beach, shelter, picnic, and play areas of the park.

### **Directions:**

Coming from the north: take I-77 South merge right onto 76W. Merge left to I-277/US 224 East. Take exit 3 (S. Main St.), go straight, becomes Swartz Rd. Go for approximately 1 mile. Turn right onto Harrington Rd. Park entrance will be the second parking lot on the right.

Coming from the south: take I-77 North then merge left onto I-277/US 224 West. Take exit 3 (S. Main St.). Turn right onto S. Main St. At the first light, turn left onto Swartz Rd. Go for approximately 1 mile. Turn right onto Harrington Rd. Park entrance will be the second parking lot on the right.
